NA/ME/OE POSITION AT WEBB INSTITUTE

Webb Institute is looking for a permanent faculty candidate to teach undergraduate engineering subjects to highly capable engineering students. The position is for someone with a strong background in either naval architecture, marine engineering, ocean engineering, or a combination of these fields. The starting rank will be either Assistant or Associate Professor, depending on background and experience. The projected starting date will be January 2017, with spring classes beginning at the end of February 2017.

Because Webb Institute is a small four-year college, the emphasis is on undergraduate teaching. Previous teaching experience is desired though not required. The successful candidate can expect to teach lower and upper-level undergraduate courses. The position requires the successful applicant to:

- Be able to teach standard undergraduate courses in naval architecture, marine engineering, or ocean engineering, and engineering sciences. Certain courses include a laboratory component.
- Be able to supervise student research projects.

The selected candidate will be expected to teach undergraduate classes as his/her primary responsibility. The typical course load is two classes each semester, totaling six to eight credits. The selected candidate will also be expected to serve on faculty committees and to participate actively in Webb community activities. In addition, the faculty member will be encouraged and given opportunities to engage in research or other forms of professional development.

Ideally, applicants should have an appropriate earned doctorate, but a Bachelor's degree in science or engineering plus a Master's degree in the same or a closely-related discipline is required. Practical experience in the marine industry is highly desirable.
