Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

3. Develops and documents all Engineering Change Proposals (ECPs); secures approval and required signatures of customer, updates specifications and material lists for ECPs; and communicates ECP information to the Production Manager, Technical Manager, Craft Supervisors and Naval Architect/Engineer.
4. Is the company liaison, in conjunction with QA, to the USCG, or other regulatory bodies, for production inspections, final inspections, and certification documentation on the assigned project.
5. Act as a reference source for technical or production questions from the AAM crew or customers on an assigned project.

- Intermediate to advanced proficiency knowledge level of USCG Standards.
- Ability to successfully work with staff and customers with varying personalities and proactively address differences of opinion or differences in methodology.
