### June Paper: **A Cornucopia of Structural Challenges – Solved, Ongoing, Opportunities for the Future?**

**Presenter:** Dr. John C Daidola, P.E., Assistant Professor of Structural Engineering, Webb Institute

Over the years as a variety of issues have confronted the maritime industry ship structure has played a significant role as a principal concern or part of the solution. Although a number of the areas of interest have received attention when first considered, continual change and the potential for additional opportunities have resulted in continued interest. This presentation will consider some of the more principal areas addressed including collision and grounding, hull stiffness and vibratory response, producibility, naval vessel rules, the offshore industry, and reliability based design.

**Presenter's bio:**

Dr. John C. Daidola is Asst. Professor at Webb Institute. He is also President and Technical Director of AENY naval architects and marine engineers as well as Adjunct Professor for the USMMA MMARE Program. Dr. Daidola holds B.S.E and M.S.E. degrees from the University of Michigan in Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering, and a Ph.D. from Steven Institute in Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering. He is a registered Professional Engineer in seventeen states. Dr. Daidola's interests include design, structure, hydrodynamics, propulsion and ship production and he has had application in these disciplines from both research and design perspectives. Dr. Daidola is a Fellow SNAME and Chair of the ASNE Metropolitan Section.
